Worshipful Masters Message

In our fellow craft degree, we are taught that feeling is one of our essential human senses. We are also instructed on the various grips and tokens, each having their own distinct meanings behind their teachings, which are expressed in the simplest form of a handshake. The first recordings of the handshake date back to 5th century B.C. Greece. The handshake is believed to have originated as a gesture of peace by demonstrating that the hand holds no weapon. The Romans, who liked to hide daggers in the sleeves of their robes, used to grab each other's sleeves to make sure there was peace as well. When people made agreements in the Middle Ages, the treaties were rarely ever written down. To finalize the deal a gesture was used, the handshake eventually becoming the common expression alongside an oath.

There is an old saying that "A man's handshake is his bond". Once he has shaken on it, he has agreed to it. One who did not keep his word would lose all the respect of his fellow man, now not to be trusted. A handshake was more than just a greeting of friendship. Today a handshake is just a form of greeting, one becoming increasingly phased out as the years go by. We now see more informal ways of greeting each other such as fist bumps, or elbow bumps in today's crazy world, rather than the standard handshake. It no longer has the same ramifications, legal or personal, as before. However, for us as Freemasons the handshake still has great meaning. Those who learn it are taught to live by the three basic tenets of Freemasonry: Friendship, Morality, and Brotherly Love. These tenets teach us: how to treat each other, to meet on the level as friends, the expectation of honorable conduct, and how to work with others in a civil manner. Such a handshake binds two people together and represents the type of relationship and rapport you can expect between brothers. May brotherly love prevail and peace and kindness reach all of our hearts.






