"No greater love"

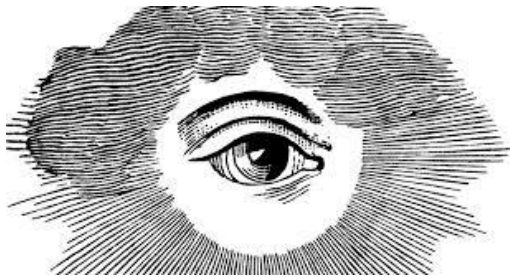
