Assumptions are dangerous things to make, and like all dangerous things; to make even the tiniest mistake you can find yourself in trouble. Making assumptions simply means believing things are a certain way with little or no evidence that shows you are correct. You can see at once how this can be a problem.

We have the tendency to make assumptions too often. The true problem with making these assumptions is that we can start to believe they are the truth. We make assumptions about what others are doing or thinking. Then, we take it personally. We make assumptions; we misunderstand and end up creating drama and stress for nothing. A lot of the sadness and difficulty you have in your life was rooted in making assumptions and taking things personally. We tend to only see what we want to see and hear what we want to hear. We do not perceive things the way they are. We literally dream up things in our imagination. One assumption leads to another assumption; we then jump to conclusions, and we take our story very personally. We also make the assumption that everyone sees life the way we do. We assume that others think the way we think, feel the way we feel and judge the way we judge. This is the biggest assumption humans make. Because we don't understand something, we make an assumption about the meaning, and when the truth comes out, we often find out it is not what we thought at all.

The way to keep yourself from making assumptions is to have the courage to ask questions. Once you have the answers to the questions, you won't have to assume anything at all because you will have the truth. Also, find your voice to ask for what you want. Everyone has the right to say yes or no, but you always have the right to ask. Likewise, everyone has the right to ask you. Do not be fearful to ask for clarification. It is always better to ask questions, because assumptions can set us up for unneeded hardship. Remember, "Hypocrisy and deceit are unknown among us, sincerity and plain dealing distinguish us, and the heart and the tongue join in promoting each other's welfare ..."

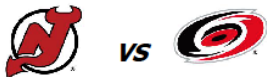
