Worshipful Masters Message

These days instant gratification has become the norm. As a result, we forget the importance of patience, studying, and taking the time to earn and learn. I came across this passage written by Brother Charles Clyde Hunt that explains why our Masonic Journey is a lifelong endeavor.

In an old Gaelic poem called "The Poem of Trathel," there is a scene which pictures a mother playing a harp while her children gather around, entranced as they listen to the sweet strains which issue from the harp at her touch on the trembling strings. She stops. The music ceases, and she lays down the harp.

The children pick it up and finger the strings in an attempt to reproduce the music which had come from the harp at the touch of their mothers' fingers. In vain. A confusion of harsh discoordination sounds come forth but not the sweet music they longed to hear as a result of their own efforts. In bitter disappointment they cry out, "Oh Mother, why doesn't it answer us too? Show us where the music is."

She replies, "My children, it is a secret I cannot tell you, nor can it be told except in the presence of Wisdom, Strength, and Beauty. Wisdom to discern True, Strength to resist Error, and Appreciation of Spiritual Beauty, qualities which you must acquire for yourselves.

The music is in the strings, but the power to draw it out is not mine to give you. I can help but you must see and find it for yourselves. If you truly wish to acquire this power, you can do so, but think not the task easy. It will come when you have earned it, but only after long and patient search.

So, it is with us, our unaccustomed fingers wander among the wires of the harp. We seek the strings where dwells the harmony of the soul. We seek the lost song, the lost chord, the lost word.

Yet after all it is not really lost. The sweet harmony is in the strings all the time. We must learn, by study and practice, the art of drawing it out. In like manner, the Word we call lost is near at hand, even in our own hearts. It is we ourselves who lack the power to recognize it. The harmony of the soul is in the harp of life. It is not lost, and we can acquire the power to draw it forth if we only patiently seek and work for it.

This search for harmony unheard by mortal ears, the harmony discerned only by the spiritual ear of the soul attuned to the divine strings of the heavenly harp, is the great purpose of Masonry, we call it the search for the Lost word.

EDICT

WHEREAS, R.W. BROTHER GARY J. OLSEN has engaged in conduct that has been perceived to have menaced the peace and harmony of the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Charges of Unmasonic Conduct have been filed with the Grand Secretary of the Grand Lodge, which relate to affairs of the Grand Lodge, which charges have been received and accepted; and

WHEREAS, it is my determination, as Grand Master, that in order to restore, and preserve, the peace and harmony of the Fraternity, which would be further jeopardized should any local lodge assume jurisdiction over what are essentially offenses against, and involve the affairs of the Grand Lodge; and

WHEREAS, a trial of these charges in which the accuser may present evidence of the alleged Unmasonic Conduct; and in which **R.W. BROTHER GARY J. OLSEN** may have the opportunity to defend against such charges, is necessary; and

WHEREAS, R.W. BROTHER GARY J. OLSEN has a reasonable expectation of being treated fairly;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the Authority in me vested as Grand Master of Masons for the State of New Jersey, **IT IS EDICTED AND ORDERED** that the provisions of Title Four, Article XI, "The Code for Trial of Charges", be and hereby is suspended to the extent necessary, and that a Special Lodge of Judgment is hereby created to conduct such trial and to determine that guilt or innocence of **R.W. BROTHER GARY J. OLSEN**; and if found guilty, the appropriate penalty relating thereto; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Trial Panel of said Lodge of Judgment shall consist of members of the

Grand Lodge Committee for the Trial of Charges who shall be so designated by the Chairman of that

Committee who is designated to preside over said trial, and he may apply so much of the rules from the

Code for the Trial of Charges as he shall deem appropriate for the conduct of the trial; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the trial shall proceed with as much dispatch as the Chairman shall determine is appropriate to afford **R.W. BROTHER GARY J. OLSEN** the full opportunity to defend the charges filed against him; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Edict, together with a copy of the charges, shall be immediately served upon **R.W. BROTHER GARY J. OLSEN** who shall have 20 days thereafter to serve upon the Grand Secretary, his answer and defenses to the charges in writing. A copy of this Edict shall also be served upon every lodge within this Grand Jurisdiction.


