Worshipful Masters Message

During the middle chamber lecture we hear about the story of Jephthah a judge of Israel and his conquest over not only the Ammonites but also the Ephramites. But there is another story of Jephthah that is even more interesting because it shows his resolve as a man of faith. But this could be from his very interesting history, and life.

Jephthah's story begins in an interesting fashion. His life starts as a product of a relationship between his father, who was a man of Gilead. While his mother is, what we would think of today as a prostitute. He lived with his father for some time but was eventually chased away from his familiar home by his two half-brothers. While he was on his own, he ended up associating with some very unscrupulous characters. Whom over time assisted him to climbing through the social ranks to a Judge of Israel. This title is an equivalent to a war chief, or governor of a tribe, rather than a king. So, his path to leadership was through blood and strength, rather than through politics or birthrights.

So, at the beginning of the Ammonitish War, Jephthah made a vow that if they were to be victorious, He would offer up a burnt offering of whoever met him at his front door first. Sadly, as fate would have it his only child, a daughter, was the first to meet Jephthah. But being a man fearful of his creator, he intended to follow through on sacrificing his daughter. To this there are some debates among scholars as to the truth of him following through on the sacrifice of his daughter. Some believe that she was not burned as an offering, and that she had to live out her days in total seclusion.

A lot of the stories that I have read in putting together this message show Jephthah as a leader who managed through sheer will and force, up to and including the sacrifice of his own beloved child. Today we are far more "Civilized" our version of the leadership, can be just as emotionally brutal. We are all leaders in some way shape or form. Be it in a lodge room, or our church community, or our local town. Always remember to not allow emotion to rule you and be your driving force behind your decisions.

The View from the West R.W. Scott P Vicari ATTGM

Our first meeting in June falls on Friday, June 6th, the 81st anniversary of the Allied Invasion of Europe, which was code named "Operation Overlord," or more commonly known as, D-Day. Almost 7,000 naval vessels, including battleships, destroyers, minesweepers, escorts and assault craft moved over 150,000 troops to the five beaches in Normandy, France, where the invasion took place. The number of allied troops killed in the action is estimated between 2,500 to over 4,000. It was the largest naval, air and land operation in history. General Omar N. Bradley was commander of the First Army over Operation Overlord. He was known for the special care and attention he provided the men under his command, which earned him the moniker, "the Soldiers General." General Bradley was also a Freemason. On September 23, 1923, while teaching mathematics at West Point, Omar petitioned the Lodge closest to the Academy, West Point Lodge #877, F & AM. On the petition, filled out in Omar's own hand, he professed his belief in God, stated his address was West Point, New York and listed his occupation as "Officer, United States Army." He was raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason on November 15, 1923. Many other Freemasons participated in "Operation Overlord." Among the many heroes of D-Day was Brother Leonard "Bud" Lomell, who found and destroyed five 155millimeter German guns camouflaged in an orchard. The guns were positioned to fire toward Utah and Omaha Beach where American troops were landing. Bro. Lomell's action potentially saved thousands of American lives that day. I think it is important to remember that if it were not for these, and thousands of other brave men and women in the military, we would not be able to hold our regular communication this June 6th, or any other time. Hitler, who thought Freemasons were part of a conspiracy working against the interests of German nationalism, persecuted and sent 100,000 of them to his concentration camps (next year R.W. brother Berkowitz will present his paper on this fascinating subject to our lodge). If Hitler had realized his dream of world domination, Freemasonry, as we know it, would have ended. It's a good thing we won!




